The town of Aki-ota is located in a quasi-national park in the northwestern part of Hiroshima Prefecture. The area is known as a heavy snow region in Japan and has a variety of ski resorts. In 1963, the town registered over four meters of accumulated snow.

At present, the number of residents in the town is about 7,000. It is known as the least populated municipality in Hiroshima Prefecture, with the highest percentage of elderly citizens at nearly 47%.

In these circumstances, snow shoveling in the town has become a major problem. For a town with many elderly citizens, assistance from the outside is sorely needed.

Against this backdrop, the Aki-ota Town Tourist Association has created a tour called the “Heavy Snow Region Experience Tour.”

There are three main components: “Assistance with problem solving” in the mountainous town, the “Heavy snow experience”, which most urban dwellers never experience in their daily lives, and the “Hands-on experience with local people” living in a snowy region of Japan.

You can experience real excitement in Aki-ota, where the original atmosphere of Japan still remains!
